PROGRAM CRITERIA

- Permanent Resident, Convention Refugee, or CUAET Status.
- Must have CLB level 4 or above.
- Must be currently living in Canada.
- Self-identifying immigrant woman. This program is open to non-binary and gender-diverse people.
