



MY BEST FRIEND'S CLOSET PROGRAM

My Best Friend's Closet is a youth empowerment program that provides high-quality, used, and donated fashionable clothing, shoes, and accessories to in-need, low-income youth, ages 12-18, identifying as female for their school and recreational needs.

During a 90-minute appointment, youth are connected with a near-to-peer volunteer mentor who will help them select items that suit their unique style and individuality at no cost. Clients are allowed up to 2 visits, a minimum of 12 months apart.
